

Recently hailed by the BBC as “one of the biggest names in UK dance”, Belfast-born/London-based duo Bicep (Matt McBriar & Andy Ferguson) continue to cement themselves as one of the defining global electronic acts of our times. Their latest single, “Water”, follows a year in which almost 1m people will have had the chance to see Bicep play live, including headline performances at Glastonbury — where they closed the festival’s second biggest stage with a now legendary televised set — Primavera (Barcelona & LA), Parklife, Wide Awake, AVA & Field Day.

Bicep released their hotly anticipated second album, ‘Isles’, in January 2021. Met with widespread acclaim from critics & fans alike, ‘Isles’ was described as “a tour de force of neon euphoria” (Resident Advisor), “brimming with restless energy” (Evening Standard), “one of the defining dance music albums of 2021” (Mixmag), “intricate, moody, nostalgic, introspective and emotional” (Billboard) & named The Guardian’s ‘Album of the Week’. It debuted at #2 on the UK Official Albums Chart and #1 on the UK Official Vinyl Albums Chart, earning the duo two BRITs nominations — for Best British Group & Breakthrough Act — in the process.

Bicep will soon play some of their biggest shows to date with back-to-back sold-out performances at London’s 10k capacity Alexandra Palace, a headline arena tour throughout Europe and a run of high-profile festival & headline shows across Australia in the new year.
